Call for Entries: The 48th Annual Fall Show 2013

The Art Association of Henry County has issued a Call for Entries for its 48th Annual Fall Show 2013, sponsored by Pfenninger, Claxton & Estelle Insurance Group.

The show is open to any two or three dimensional work completed in the last three years by **current** members of The Art Association of Henry County. If you need to become a member or have not renewed your membership for 2013, please fill out the membership form at the back of this newsletter, or pick up a membership application for m at the Art Center.

Works previously entered in any AAHC Fall Show are not eligible for entry. All work must be original. Work must remain at the Art Center Gallery for the full term of the exhibit (September 15 through October 20, 2013). The Exhibit Committee reserves the right to reject any work deemed unsuitable to hang in the Art Association Galleries.

Entry fee is \$20. Each artist may enter up to three works of art. Cash awards of more than \$1,500 will be presented, including a \$200 Best of Show award selected at the discretion of the judge and announced at the opening reception Thursday, September 19 from 6 – 8 p.m.
