A Word from the Executive Director

The fourth quarter of 2022 has been exciting at the Art Association! Our shows have included the 57th Annual Members Show and the Holiday Art Sale.

Our classes this quarter included Pam Newell Still Life and Homeschool Art with Kelly Ruhl.

The Holiday season was full of life and good cheer. The Arts Park was decked out in all its holiday glory with a breathtaking light display, the planning and fundraising of which has taken over a year. The "Big Light Reveal" included a Christmas Market in the Pavilion and the Annual Christmas Walk brought literally thousands of people to the Park. We had a successful Premier Holiday Art Sale that will recur annually. The ever-popular Mistletoe & Martinis reception and silent auction was a wonderful evening enjoyed by all. The St. Croix Raffle was a big success, and the winner is...Mickie Hoy!

AAHC has received grants from The Henry County Community Foundation to reroof the Artistry Annex, an Intern grant, allowing us to hire Carmen Davis, as well as the Foundations generous yearly endowment. Also, the Food and Beverage Tax Fund to reroof the Pavilion, the Efroymson Family Fund for the building of a new environmentally controlled vault to house the Permanent Collection, as well as the Building Renovation Assistance Program for repair of the Annex foundation. The "Lift Up & Light Up" fundraising campaign (nicknamed LULU) was wildly successful! This community, in its amazing generosity, raised over \$30,000 and AAHC received a \$30,000 matching grant from the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority! This money was/is being used to light up the Arts Park and replace the Pavilion posts.

We have art for sale in Twin Lions and Café Royal and are in negotiations with another couple of places to display artists pieces.


